A Bass Chapel Preface

addendum to Chapter 22, section 8

\*\*\*[Bass Chapel does not desire to bind the conscience of the believer in this section. We do affirm the necessity of regular corporate worship on the Lord's Day, but we also affirm the command to provide for your family, which may be required on Sundays. These two commands should not be at odds, so Christian liberty is applied for those who believe Sunday to be a direct replacement for the Old Testament Sabbath, and also for the Christian who believes the Lord's Day gathering is different from the Old Testament Sabbath. Christ is our Sabbath.]
